



## COVID-19 INFORMATION

Our measures and procedures are under constant review and will be updated as advice from the UK and Scottish Governments and health authorities is updated.

With the advice of medical experts, The R&A has put in place robust, monitored measures to help safeguard everyone involved in the championship.

### **PLAYERS TRAVELLING FROM OUTSIDE SCOTLAND**

**At present, under current Scottish law, given the state of the epidemic, you must not travel between Scotland and any other country unless you have a reasonable excuse (see [exceptions](#)).**

**This includes;**

- England
- Northern Ireland
- Wales
- Republic of Ireland
- Jersey
- Guernsey
- The Isle of Man

**This applies to all travel, by train, ferry, coach, air or any other route.**

**An update on these travel restrictions is expected no later than the 17<sup>th</sup> May.**

Currently, if you're travelling from outside the UK into England, you must either quarantine in the place you're staying or in a managed quarantine hotel for 10 days because of coronavirus (COVID-19). What you need to do depends on where you travel in the 10 days before you arrive in England.

You must also get 2 coronavirus tests after you arrive in England. You would need to book these before you travel.
