The Sunshine Ladies Tour was established in 2014 to create playing opportunities to women professional and amateur golfers who seek a career in golf.

The Sunshine Ladies Tour has grown from 7 to 9 events since inception and is played during the South African summer months of January to April.

The Sunshine Ladies Tour potentially serves as a warm-up Tour to female professional golfers who have, or who want to, achieve playing privileges on the LET Access, Ladies European Tour and LPGA Tours respectively.

The Sunshine Ladies Tour gives professional and amateur golfers the opportunity to play in a competitive environment, against local and international players with the same goal of joining the more established tours mentioned above. Through this, friendships are established across different cultures, countries and continents.

The Sunshine Ladies Tour is supported in various administrative ways by the Southern Africa PGA Tour, who manage the Sunshine Tour, being the men's professional golf tour in Southern Africa.

The Sunshine Ladies Tour appreciates the support of the R & A and is committed to growing the game of golf amongst women in Southern Africa.

In support of the Women in Golf Charter, the Sunshine Ladies Tour pledges to:

1. Continue to create tournament playing opportunities for young female professionals and amateurs, from across the world and Africa, who seek to pursue a career in professional tournament golf or golf administration, by actively finding sponsors for new events and maintaining and improving current events.
2. Assist in preparing prospective professionals for the bigger stage of competitive professional golf (e.g. LET or LPGA) by equipping them while they are still amateurs.
3. Creating job opportunities for women in Administration and Event planning and execution.
4. Host junior clinics at most events, introducing the game of golf to young women.
5. Have a social media presence on various platforms throughout the year to encourage women of all ages and cultures to take up the game of golf or a career in golf.



6. Show case the growth of individuals to stimulate further interest within the golf industry.
