### Women in Golf Charter

Women's Golf Day was founded in 2016 and is designed as a single-day event scheduled the first Tuesday of every June to introduce new female participants to the game and celebrate existing players by joining them together irrespective of race, religion, language, ethnicity, or location.

Since inception, Women's Golf Day has been dedicated to introducing more women to golf in an inclusive environment and connecting the global golf community with the mission to engage, empower and support women through golf. To date over 900 locations in 52 countries have participated.

Since 2016, Women's Golf Day has engaged female owned companies, created a global ambassador program largely made up of females and actively works with numerous interns and volunteers to give them experience and exposure to the golf industry and business.

As a signatory of the Women in Golf Charter, Women's Golf Day will pledge to:

- Increase the number of venues globally to be part of Women's Golf Day
- Share inspirational stories, case studies and celebrate women in golf
- In cooperation with our partners and governing bodies we will track participation on Women's Golf Day and measure the engagement of new audiences and growing interest
- Continue to work with stakeholders and supporters to spread positive messaging and imagery of women in golf
- Promote the Charter and encourage venues to become signatories
